(a) The following classes of manufacturer's licenses shall be issued at the designated annual fees:

- (g) (l) A Class 6 [Baltimore City] pub-brewery license shall be issued:
 - (i) By the State Comptroller; and
- (ii) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS, OR Baltimore City.
- (2) A holder of a Class 6 [Baltimore City] pub-brewery license:
- (i) May brew malt beverages at a single location for consumption on the restaurant premises; and
- (ii) Is limited to the brewing of 2,000 barrels of malt beverage each calendar year.
- (3) The pub-brewery premises shall be located immediately adjacent to the restaurant where the brewed beverage is to be sold to the public.
