## CHAPTER 456

(House Bill 1073)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County, Charles, and St. Mary's Counties - Property Tax Credit - Agricultural Use Buildings

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body <u>bodies</u> of Calvert County, <u>Charles</u>, <u>and St. Many's Counties</u> to grant, by law, a property tax credit against certain buildings used for certain agricultural activities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (B) (C) THE GOVERNING BODY OF CALVERT COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON A BUILDING OTHER THAN A TOBACCO BARN THAT IS:
- (1) LOCATED ON LAND THAT QUALIFIES FOR AN AGRICULTURAL USE ASSESSMENT; AND
