

(2) LEASED TO THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR USE AS A POST OFFICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989. It shall remain effective for a period of five years and, at the end of June 30, 1994, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION -2- 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
