

AN ACT concerning

Milk Products

FOR the purpose of altering provisions relating to milk products, the milk permit process, and standards and handling requirements; and generally relating to milk products.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

21-401.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Bobtailer" means a person who operates or controls a GRADE A milk route and distributes GRADE A pasteurized milk products that the person buys from a GRADE A distributor or a milk processor.

(c) "Certified industry dairy farm inspector" means an individual who is certified by the Secretary under § 21-414 of this subtitle.

(d) "Dairy farm" means a place where at least 1 cow or goat is kept, and from which the milk is sold or offered for sale.

(e) "Departmental inspection area" means the area in which the Department routinely makes inspections under this subtitle.
