6-305. APPLICATIONS FOR STATE LICENSES.

AT LEAST 45 DAYS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION DATE, AN APPLICANT FOR A STATE LICENSE SHALL:

- (1) SUBMIT TO THE STATE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE STATE BOARD PROVIDES; AND
  - (2) PAY TO THE STATE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$35.

6-306. EXAMINATIONS.

(A) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A STATE LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, AT THE DATES, TIMES, AND PLACES THAT THE STATE BOARD DETERMINES.

- (C) NOTICE OF EXAMINATION.
- (1) AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY EACH APPLICANT WHETHER THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO BE EXAMINED UNDER THIS SECTION.
