obligation bonds of the County for such purpose, or (ii) revenue bonds issued pursuant to any authority authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to finance the hospital improvements or (iii) any combination of (i) and (ii); in connection with such agreement (without in any way creating any limitation on the discretion of the County) the County may further agree, in its discretion, that any interest (actual or implied) of the County in the hospital or in any receipts or assets of the hospital may be subordinated to the interests of the holders of any revenue bonds issued to finance the hospital improvements, all as may be determined in the absolute discretion of the County.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County may SECTION 5. enter into an agreement or agreements with Frederick Memorial Hospital, Inc., pursuant to which that corporation shall be required to make periodic payments from the hospital's revenues or other assets to the County at such times and in such amounts to assure the timely payment of the maturing principal of and interest on said bonds and any expenses of the County in connection therewith. However, the bonds shall constitute, and they shall so recite, an irrevocable pledge of the full faith and credit and unlimited taxing power of the County to the payment of the maturing principal of and interest on the bonds as and when they become payable. In each and every fiscal year that the bonds are outstanding, the County shall levy or cause to be levied ad valorem taxes upon all the assessable property within the corporate limits of the County in rate and amount sufficient to provide for or assure the payment, when due, of the principal and interest on all the bonds maturing in such fiscal year and, if the proceeds from the taxes so levied in any fiscal prove inadequate for such payment, additional taxes shall be levied in the succeeding fiscal year to make up any such deficiency. The County may apply to the payment of the principal of and interest on any bonds issued hereunder any funds received by it from the State of Maryland, the United States of America, any agency or instrumentality thereof, or from Frederick Memorial Hospital, Inc., or from any other source. If such funds are available for the purpose of assisting the County or the hospital in financing the construction of additions and improvements Frederick Memorial Hospital, taxes that might otherwise required to be levied under this Act may be reduced or need not be levied.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County is hereby authorized and empowered, at any time and from time to time to issue its bonds in the manner hereinabove described for the purpose of refunding, upon purchase or redemption, any bonds issued hereunder. The validity of any such refunding bonds shall in no way be dependent upon or related to the validity or invalidity of the obligations so refunded. The powers herein granted with respect to the issuance of bonds, and also the limitations herein on such powers shall be applicable to the issuance of refunding bonds. Said refunding bonds may be issued
