- (2) A holder of a Class 7 [Baltimore City]
  micro-brewery license:
- (i) May brew and bottle malt beverages at a single location; and
- $% \left( 11\right) =0$  (ii) May not brew more than 10,000 barrels of malt beverage each calendar year.
- (3) (i) The on-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell at retail beer brewed under this license to customers for consumption on the licensed premises.
- (ii) The off-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell and deliver beer brewed under this license to:
- Any wholesaler licensed under this article to sell beer in this State; or
- 2. Any person who is located in a state other than Maryland who is authorized under the laws of that state to receive brewed beverages.
  - (4) A holder of a Class 7 micro-brewery license:
- (i) May not own, operate or be affiliated with any other manufacturer of beer[, either in or outside the City of Baltimore]; and
- (ii) Notwithstanding subsection (g) of this section, may not be granted a wholesale alcoholic beverages license.
- (5) The days and time of consumer sales under this license are as established:
- (i)--IN--BALTIMORE--CITY,--by-the-Baltimore-City board-of-license-commissioners;-AND
