SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

(a) (1) The Attorney General may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget.

(2) Staff appointed under this subsection serves at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
