CHAPTER 508

(House Bill 479)

AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pension Systems - Retired Members -  
Reemployment as Elected Official

FOR the purpose of excluding certain members of the Employees' Retirement System, the Teachers' Retirement System, the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland, or the Pension System for Teachers of the State of Maryland from certain restrictions on retirement benefits upon reemployment under certain circumstances; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally relating to retirement benefits for reemployed members of the Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems.

Preamble

WHEREAS, Article 73B, §§ 11(15)(b), 86(9)(b), 117(14)(b), and 145(13)(b) of the Annotated Code provide for reemployment of a member of the Employees' Retirement System, the Teachers' Retirement System, the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland, and the Pension System for Teachers of the State of Maryland, respectively; and

WHEREAS, Each of those provisions requires that if a retired member is reemployed in a permanent position with a participating municipal corporation, that member's retirement allowance payments shall be suspended until the member's later retirement; now, therefore,
