

(II) THE WS PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE CONSUMPTION OF WINE FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES:

1. ON CLASS B BEER AND WINE OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSED PREMISES WITH THE CONSENT OF THE LICENSEE; OR

2. ON PREMISES WITHOUT A PERMANENT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.

(III) THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN 2 OUNCES FROM EACH BRAND TO ANY 1 PERSON.

(IV) THE BONA FIDE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION:

1. SHALL APPLY FOR A WS PERMIT AT LEAST 15 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DAY OF ISSUANCE; AND

2. MAY NOT BE ISSUED MORE THAN 12 WS PERMITS IN ANY GIVEN LICENSE YEAR.

(V) THE PERMIT FEE IS \$15 PER DAY.

(VI) THE WS PERMIT HOLDER IS AUTHORIZED TO BRING WINE ON TO CLASS B LICENSED PREMISES FOR SAMPLING OR TASTING PURPOSES ONLY.

(4) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION ARE NOT RESTRICTED BY:

(I) THE PROVISIONS IN SUBSECTION (B) OF § 114 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(II) THE PROVISIONS OF LAW UNDER § 41 OF THIS ARTICLE PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF 2 LICENSES FOR THE SAME PREMISES.

[(2)] (5) In the City of Annapolis, the Mayor and City Council may approve the issuance of a BWT license OR A WS PERMIT. The [cost of the license is] FEES FOR A LICENSE AND THE PERMIT SHALL BE set by the Mayor and City Council.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
