

CHAPTER 512

(House Bill 614)

AN ACT concerning

Hunting - Wearing Fluorescent Clothing to Hunt
Game-Mammals Wildlife

FOR the purpose of requiring certain persons to wear certain fluorescent clothing while hunting certain game-mammals wildlife or while accompanying, aiding, or assisting another person to hunt certain game-mammals wildlife; providing for exceptions for certain persons; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to the wearing of certain fluorescent clothing when hunting game-mammals wildlife or accompanying, aiding, or assisting another person to hunt game--mammals wildlife.
