

(b) In Charles and St. Mary's counties this section does not apply to the sale or negotiation for sale of industrial property.

(C) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE CONTRACT FOR SALE OR NEGOTIATION FOR SALE OF PROPERTY ZONED INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL, OR BOTH INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL, IF A PLAT IS APPROVED AND RECORDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER OF LAND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
