

THE ASSESSMENT UNDER § 7-507.1(D) HAS BEEN REMITTED TO THE FISCAL AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE COAL WAS REMOVED.

(E) AT THE END OF ANY MONTH WHEN THE AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE BOND SUPPLEMENT RESERVE IS REDUCED BELOW \$200,000:

(1) THE ASSESSMENT UNDER § 7-507.1(D) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL RESUME; AND

(2) DEPOSITS INTO THE BOND SUPPLEMENT RESERVE OF THE AMOUNTS IN SUBSECTION (B)(1), (2), AND (3) OF THIS SECTION SHALL RESUME.

(F) THE SECRETARY SHALL NOTIFY EACH COUNTY WHEN REMITTING OR SUSPENDING THE REMITTANCE OF THE AMOUNT UNDER § 7-507.1.(B)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(G) THE SECRETARY SHALL MEET AND CONFER WITH THE LAND RECLAMATION COMMITTEE AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE PROCURING ANY SERVICES FOR WHICH FUNDS FROM THE BOND SUPPLEMENT RESERVE WILL BE USED, AND SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMITTEE AN OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ABOUT THE PROPOSED EXPENDITURE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 532

(House Bill 1404)

AN ACT concerning

State Police - Vesting of Retirement Allowance

FOR the purpose of altering the number of years of creditable service in the Maryland State Police necessary to be rendered before a person becomes eligible for a vested retirement allowance for a person whose service is terminated after a certain date; and expressing legislative intent concerning the prospective nature of this Act.
