- (2) Before reimbursement under this subsection, the [Director] SECRETARY shall be satisfied that the actions of the foster parent did not contribute substantially to the bodily injury or property damage sustained.
- (3) Reimbursement under this subsection shall be made for all costs to a maximum amount of \$5,000. However, all payments in excess of \$500 require the approval of the Board of Public Works.

## Article - State Government

## 8-201.

- (a) The Executive Branch of the State government shall have not more than 21 principal departments, each of which shall embrace a broad, functional area of that Branch.
- (b) The principal departments of the Executive Branch of the State government are:
  - (1) Agriculture;
  - (2) Budget and Fiscal Planning;
  - (3) Economic and Employment Development;
  - (4) The Environment;
  - (5) General Services:
  - (6) Health and Mental Hygiene;
  - (7) Housing and Community Development;
  - (8) Human Resources;
  - (9) Licensing and Regulation;
  - (10) Natural Resources;
  - (11) Personnel;
  - (12) Public Safety and Correctional Services:
  - (13) State Planning; [and]
  - (14) Transportation; AND
  - (15) JUVENILE SERVICES.
