respect to the effect of the plan within its governmental subdivision on or before the date of the hearing.

Article 20A - Tri-County Council of Western Maryland 2-202.

Without limiting or restricting the general powers conferred by this article, the Council may do any of the following:

(9) Review any applications to agencies of the State or federal government for loans or grants-in-aid for projects by governmental subdivisions within the region as may be submitted directly to the Tri-county Council or as provided through the Maryland [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning State Intergovernmental Assistance Clearinghouse;

3-102.

- (a) Before the plan, or any part, is adopted, it shall be submitted to the [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning and to the local planning commission, and governing body of each governmental subdivision within the region, not less than 60 days prior to a public hearing.
- (c) (1) The [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning may make recommendations to the Council, on or before the date of the hearing, for its modification where necessary to achieve conformity with State plans and policies.

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions 6-301.

- (a) After consultation with the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning, the [Secretary] DIRECTOR of [State] Planning shall adopt regulations that require a local government to submit information, as required in this section, on federal aid, including grants, instructional contracts, loans, research contracts, or other assistance.
- (b) (1) Each 6 months, a local government shall submit a summary notice to the [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning if, during the 6-month period that the notice covers, the local government has received an award of federal aid in the form of an instructional contract, instructional grant, research contract, or research grant.
- (2) The summary notice shall state the amount of the award.
