- [The Secretary of State Planning, the] THE Secretary of Economic and Community Development, THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING, the chairman of the Maryland Arts Council, and the members of the Cultural Advisory Council serve as ex officio members of the board and may appoint alternates to serve in their absence. An ex officio member does not have voting rights.
- The Speaker of the House shall appoint a member of the House of Delegates as a liaison to the board and President of the Senate shall appoint a member of the Senate as a liaison to the board. Both the Delegate and the Senator shall be representatives of legislative districts within the region. They shall serve in an advisory capacity only to the board, and may not have voting rights.

(a) Each county shall develop, with the assistance of the [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning, a needs assessment and recommendations for the delivery of before- and after-school child care services to children who are at least 4 years old but not more than 14 years old.

Article 66B - Zoning and Planning

3.09.

The planning commission shall annually prepare, adopt, file an annual report with the local legislative body. annual report shall be made available for public inspection and a copy of the report shall be mailed to the [Secretary] DIRECTOR of [State] Planning. The annual report shall (a) index and locate on a map all changes in development patterns including land use, transportation, community facilities patterns, zoning amendments, and subdivision plats which occurred during the period covered by the report, and shall state whether these changes are or are not consistent with each other, with the recommendations of the last annual report, with adopted plans of the jurisdiction, with adopted plans of all adjoining planning jurisdictions, and with adopted plans of State and local jurisdictions that have responsibility for financing or constructing public improvements necessary to implement the jurisdiction's plan; (b) contain statements and recommendations for improving the planning and development process within the jurisdiction. The local legislative body shall review the annual report and direct that such studies and other actions as appropriate and necessary be undertaken to insure continuation of a viable planning and development process.
