To carry out the objectives of this article, the following State units shall cooperate fully with the Agency:

Article - Agriculture

- (a) (l) The Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation shall be governed and administered by a board of trustees composed of the State Treasurer, who shall serve as an ex officio member, and the Secretary who shall serve as an ex officio member, and nine members from the State at-large to be appointed by the Governor, at least five of whom shall be farmer representatives from different areas of the State. The State Treasurer may appoint, as the Treasurer's designee, a deputy treasurer to serve on the board of trustees. One of the at-large members who is not a farmer representative shall representative of the [Department] OFFICE of [State] Planning. All of the farmer representatives shall be actively engaged, or retired from active farming. Three of the five farmer representatives shall be appointed as follows:
- (i) One from a list of three nominees submitted by the Maryland Agricultural Commission;
- (ii) One from a list of three nominees submitted by the Maryland Farm Bureau; and
- (iii) One from a list of three nominees submitted by the Maryland State Grange.
- (2) The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the board, from among the nine at-large trustees. A majority of the
