

(1) any real property that is in excess of the needs of the unit; or

(2) any substantial change to any real property owned by the State.

(b) For any real property identified under subsection (a) of this section, the Department shall:

(1) study the proper disposition of the property;

(2) determine whether any local government or unit of the State government is interested in the property; and

(3) make an appropriate recommendation to the using unit of the State government and to the Board of Public Works.

(A) THE SECRETARY OR A STAFF MEMBER OF THE DEPARTMENT DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY SHALL HAVE ACCESS TO INFORMATION IN THE--POSSESSION-OF-ANY-UNIT-OF-THE-STATE-GOVERNMENT-OF-A-REGIONAL GOVERNMENT,--OR--OF--A--LOCAL--GOVERNMENT--THAT--RELATES--TO--THE FOLLOWING:

{1}--FEDERAL-GRANTS, LOANS, OR SERVICES--AVAILABLE--TO THE-STATE;

{2}--STATE-GRANTS-TO-LOCAL-GOVERNMENTS;

{3}--ANY--OTHER--FORM-OF-INTERGOVERNMENTAL-ASSISTANCE;
AND

{4}--ANY-REAL-PROPERTY--OWNED--BY--THE--STATE--OR--ANY POLITICAL--SUBDIVISION--OF--THE--STATE THAT RELATES TO CAPITAL FACILITIES PLANNING IN THE POSSESSION OF ANY UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

(B) IF THE ENTRY IS MADE IN A MANNER SO AS TO CAUSE NO UNNECESSARY INJURY, THE SECRETARY OR A STAFF MEMBER DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY MAY ENTER, AT ANY REASONABLE HOUR, ON ANY LAND, IN ORDER TO MAKE EXAMINATIONS AND SURVEYS RELATED TO CAPITAL PROJECTS OF ANY UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT OR THE USE OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF THE DEPARTMENT DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY MAY ENTER, AT ANY REASONABLE HOUR, ON ANY STATE-OWNED LAND IN ORDER TO MAKE EXAMINATIONS AND SURVEYS THAT RELATE TO CAPITAL FACILITIES PLANNING.
