requires to determine which regional planning projects programmed by the Commission qualify for State assistance.

- (2) On or before August 1 of each year, the Commission shall provide the [Secretary] DIRECTOR with a copy of the proposed budget of the Commission for the following fiscal year. After the copy of the proposed budget is provided to the [Secretary] DIRECTOR, the Commission shall promptly notify the [Secretary of] DIRECTOR and obtain the approval of the [Secretary] DIRECTOR for any changes in the proposed budget for regional projects funded under this section.
- (f) The [Secretary] DIRECTOR may require an annual audit of the operations of the Commission that relate to any project financed wholly or partly by payments to the Commission from the [Department] OFFICE.

5-501.

The [Department] OFFICE shall establish a central depository for all general, area, and functional plans related to this title, and all amendments or revisions to these plans, that are prepared by:

- (1) any unit of the State government, of a regional government, or of a local government; or
  - (2) any interstate agency.

5-502.

Each unit of the State government, of a regional government, or of a local government, and each interstate agency, shall submit to the [Department] OFFICE the plans required by regulations adopted by the [Secretary] DIRECTOR.

5-503.

- (a) The [Department] OFFICE shall establish statewide classification standards for geographically referencing all basic planning information collected by any unit of the State government.
- (b) The classification standards may be used by any unit of the State or of a local government.

5-504.

(a) The [Department] OFFICE shall be a repository and clearinghouse for information about real property available for public use.
