(C) RECORD OF APPLICATIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A RECORD THAT, FOR EACH APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, SHOWS:

- (1) THE APPLICANT'S:
 - (I) NAME:
 - (II) AGE:
 - (III) RESIDENCE;
 - (IV) PLACE OF BUSINESS; AND
 - (V) EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS;
- (2) THE DATE OF THE APPLICATION:
- (3) WHETHER THE APPLICANT WAS REQUIRED TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION;
 - (4) THE ACTION OF THE BOARD ON THE APPLICATION;
 - (5) THE REASON FOR THE ACTION; AND
- (6) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE BOARD CONSIDERS NECESSARY.
 - (D) ROSTER OF LICENSEES.

THE BOARD SHALL:

- (1) KEEP A LIST OF ALL LICENSED FORESTERS THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS OF EACH LICENSEE;
 - (2) PROVIDE A COPY OF THE LIST:
- (I) ON REQUEST, TO ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC;
 - (II) EVERY 2 YEARS, ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, TO:
 - 1. EACH LICENSEE; AND
 - 2. THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
