

(C) RECORD OF APPLICATIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A RECORD THAT, FOR EACH APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, SHOWS:

(1) THE APPLICANT'S:

- (I) NAME;
- (II) AGE;
- (III) RESIDENCE;
- (IV) PLACE OF BUSINESS; AND
- (V) EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS;

(2) THE DATE OF THE APPLICATION;

(3) WHETHER THE APPLICANT WAS REQUIRED TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION;

(4) THE ACTION OF THE BOARD ON THE APPLICATION;

(5) THE REASON FOR THE ACTION; AND

(6) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE BOARD CONSIDERS NECESSARY.

(D) ROSTER OF LICENSEES.

THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) KEEP A LIST OF ALL LICENSED FORESTERS THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS OF EACH LICENSEE;

(2) PROVIDE A COPY OF THE LIST:

(I) ON REQUEST, TO ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC;

AND

(II) EVERY 2 YEARS, ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, TO:

- 1. EACH LICENSEE; AND
- 2. THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
