## CHAPTER 551

(Senate Bill 71)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Drivers' Licenses - Alcohol Restrictions

FOR the purpose of clarifying that an alcohol restriction on a licensee under a certain age prohibits the licensee from driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle with a certain amount of alcohol in the licensee's blood as determined by an analysis of the licensee's blood or breath; clarifying that an alcohol restriction on a licensee under a certain age prohibits the licensee from driving on attempting to drive a motor vehicle with a certain alcohol concentration as determined by an analysis of the licensee's blood or breath; making certain provisions of this Act contingent on the passage of another Act; and providing for the effective dates of this Act.
