- (2) THE FEES CHARGED SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO COVER. THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND ST OF ADMINISTERING THE PERMIT PROGRAM.
- (3) THE SECRETARY SHALL WAIVE ALL PERMIT FEES FOR LOCAL AND COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.
- (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL WAIVE ALL RENEWAL FEES FOR LOCAL AND COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.

- (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE A PERMIT TO ANY APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
  - (B.) THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH PERMIT:
    - (1) THE NAME OF THE PERMITTEE;
    - (2) THE ADDRESS OF THE PERMITTEE; AND
    - (3) THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE PERMIT.

- (A) A PERMIT EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE PERMIT IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- (B) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE PERMIT EXPIRES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND TO THE PERMIT HOLDER, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE HOLDER, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:
  - (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT PERMIT EXPIRES;
- (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE PERMIT EXPIRES; AND
  - (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL WAIVE ALL RENEWAL FEES FOR LOCAL AND COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.
- (e) (D) BEFORE THE PERMIT EXPIRES, THE PERMIT HOLDER PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE PERMIT HOLDER:
  - (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO THE PERMIT;
- (2) PAYS TO THE DEPARTMENT THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE SECRETARY; AND
