CHAPTER 584

(Senate Bill 495)

AN ACT concerning

Criminal Law - Right of Appeal - Exceptions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting under certain circumstances an appeal from an order of a sentence review panel of a circuit court; permitting an appeal from an order of a sentence review panel if the panel increases the sentence; and generally relating to appeals of decisions of sentencing review panels.
