SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

26-104.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "PORTABLE PAGER" MEANS ANY DEVICE CARRIED, WORN, TRANSPORTED BY AN INDIVIDUAL TO RECEIVE OR COMMUNICATE MESSAGES.
- (3) "PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY" MEANS THE GROUNDS OF ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION. INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT POSSESS A PORTABLE PAGER ON PUBLIC SCHOOL AN PROPERTY.
 - (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
- (1) HANDICAPPED STUDENTS USING PORTABLE PAGERS FOR MEDICAL REASONS:
 - (2) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS:
- (3) VISITORS ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY FOR AN AUTHORIZED PROGRAM, MEETING, OR FUNCTION; AND
- (4) FACULTY OR STAFF MEMBERS EMPLOYED BY A COUNTY BOARD; AND
- MEMBERS OF ANY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AMBULANCE COMPANY, OR RESCUE SQUAD, WHO ARE DESIGNATED TO POSSESS A PORTABLE PAGER ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY BY THE CHIEF OF THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AMBULANCE COMPANY, OR RESCUE SQUAD, AND THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.
- (b)--AN-INDIVIBUAL--WHO--VIOLATES--SUBSECTION--(B)--OF--THIS SECTION -- SHALL-BE-DETAINED-BY-SCHOOL-AUTHORITIES-UNTIL-THE-SCHOOL AHTHORITIES-CONTACT-A-LAW-ENFORCEMENT-OFFICER-AND-THE-VIOLATOR-IS TAKEN-INTO-CHSTODY-BY-THE-LAW-ENFORCEMENT-OFFICER:
- IF AN INDIVIDUAL VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE SCHOOL AUTHORITIES SHALL IMMEDIATELY CONTACT A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- (E) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CONTACTED BY SCHOOL AUTHORITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SHALL ARREST THE VIOLATOR AND-IMMEDIATELY-CONFISCATE-THE-PORTABLE PAGER-IN-THE-POSSESSION-OF-THE-VIOLATOR.
