- (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD A REINSTATEMENT FEE OF \$50, IN ADDITION TO THE RENEWAL FEE REQUIRED UNDER § 4-311 OR § 4-312 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (b) If an individual has failed to renew a [master barber] license for any reason and then applies to the Board for reinstatement more than 5 years after the [master barber] license has expired, the Board shall reinstate the [master barber] license only if the individual:
- (1) meets the renewal requirements [of § 4-311] FOR THAT LICENSE UNDER § 4-311 OR § 4-312 of this subtitle; [and]
- (2) PAYS TO THE BOARD A REINSTATEMENT FEE OF \$50, IN ADDITION TO THE RENEWAL FEE REQUIRED UNDER § 4-311 OR § 4-312 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (3) FOR A MASTER BARBER LICENSE, passes the practical part of the master barber examination given by the Board.

Each [master barber] LICENSEE shall display the [master barber] license conspicuously in the barbershop where the [master barber] LICENSEE practices OR TEACHES barbering.
