- (ii)] serving as a registered apprentice for at least 3 months, in a beauty salon that holds a beauty salon permit and under the supervision of a licensed cosmetologist or a holder of a limited license to provide esthetic services; OR
- (II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING A REQUIRED PROGRAM IN PROVIDING ESTHETIC SERVICES IN A COSMETOLOGY SCHOOL THAT:
 - 1. HOLDS A SCHOOL PERMIT; OR
- 2. HOLDS A PERMIT ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE IF THE STATE HAS STANDARDS SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO OR MORE STRINGENT THAN THE STANDARDS UNDER §§ 5-512 AND 5-513 OF THIS TITLE.

- (i) [successfully completing at least 100 hours of instruction in providing manicuring services in a cosmetology school that holds a school permit; or
- (ii)] serving as a registered apprentice for at least 3 months, in a beauty salon that holds a beauty salon permit and under the supervision of a licensed cosmetologist or a holder of a limited license to provide manicuring services; OR
- (II) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING AT LEAST 100 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION IN PROVIDING MANICURING SERVICES IN A COSMETOLOGY SCHOOL THAT:
 - 1. HOLDS A SCHOOL PERMIT; OR
- 2. HOLDS A PERMIT ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE IF THE STATE HAS STANDARDS SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO OR MORE STRINGENT THAN THE STANDARDS UNDER §§ 5-512 AND 5-513 OF THIS TITLE.
