(e) (2) A subpoena issued under this subsection shall be served by:

(i) certified mail; or

(a) [(1)] Except as provided in [paragraph (2) of this] subsection (B) OF THIS SECTION, a school of cosmetology may not allow a student to practice cosmetology on the public.

[(2)] (B) A school of cosmetology may allow a student to practice cosmetology in accordance with § 5-302 or § 5-303 of this title.

[(b) (1)] Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a school of cosmetology may not advertise prices for services of students.

(2) A school of cosmetology may post in the school building a list of prices for services of students.]
