- (B) (C) (1) THE DUTY TO TAKE THE ACTIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH OF THIS SUBSECTION APICES ONLY THE ACTIONS THE PARAGRAPH (2) CIRCUMSTANCES DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- THE DUTY DESCRIBED UNDER THIS SECTION (2) IS BEEN DISCHARGED IF THE MENTAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO HAVE bicensed-under-the-heabth-occupations--article OR ADMINISTRATOR MAKES REASONABLE AND TIMELY EFFORTS TO:
 - (I) SEEK CIVIL COMMITMENT OF THE PATIENT;

 - 1. THE NATURE OF THE THREAT:
 - 2. THE IDENTITY OF THE PATIENT MAKING THE

THREAT; AND

3. THE IDENTITY OF THE SPECIFIED VICTIM

OR VICTIMS.

(€) (D) NO CAUSE OF ACTION OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION MAY ARISE UNDER ANY PATIENT CONFIDENTIALITY ACT AGAINST A MENTAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED-UNDER-THE-HEALTH--OCCUPATIONS--ARTICLE OR ADMINISTRATOR FOR CONFIDENCES DISCLOSED OR NOT DISCLOSED IN GOOD FAITH TO THIRD PARTIES IN AN EFFORT TO DISCHARGE A DUTY ARISING UNDER THIS SECTION ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION +B+ (C) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect upon or application to any cause of action arising prior to the effective date of this Act.
