CHAPTER 635

(House Bill 56)

AN ACT concerning

Licensed Alcoholic Beverages Wholesalers - Sales Outside of Maryland

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain wholesalers to directly import foreign alcoholic beverages to sell outside the State; and generally relating to licensed alcoholic beverages wholesalers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(h) (l) A nonresident dealer's permit, for the purpose of selling beer, wine, or distilled spirits to Maryland licensees authorized to receive those beverages, may be issued only to:

(i) A brewer, distiller, rectifier, bottler, manufacturer, vintner, or winery; or
