CHAPTER 642

(House Bill 148)

AN ACT concerning

Commission to Save the Lighthouses

FOR the purpose of establishing a Commission to Save the Lighthouses; providing for the membership of the Commission; charging the Commission with certain duties; requiring the Commission to issue a report and make recommendations by a certain date; providing for the termination of the Commission; and generally relating to the Commission to Save the Lighthouses.

## Preamble

WHEREAS, There are only a few lighthouses remaining in Maryland waters and they should remain at their original sites; and

WHEREAS, A united effort of federal and State government, private industry, and public interest groups is essential to save and maintain the lighthouses; and

WHEREAS, Lighthouses are appropriate-sites-to-welcome-ships to--Maryland--waters important navigational aids, cultural artifacts, and historic structures; and

WHEREAS, Immediate and concerted action is necessary to prevent further deterioration, destruction, and removal of the lighthouses; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) The Commission to Save the Lighthouses is established to investigate the problems of saving lighthouses in Maryland waters.
