

(1) Developing an inventory of the location and condition of lighthouses in Maryland waters;

~~(1)~~ (2) Determining the kind of lighthouses to be saved;

~~(2)~~ (3) Designating specific lighthouses to be saved;

~~(3)~~ (4) Determining, where necessary, new sites for lighthouses;

~~(4)~~ (5) Recommending, where appropriate, replacement of site markers with scenic structures;

~~(5) -- Developing -- appropriate signboards to be attached to lighthouses welcoming ships to Maryland waters;~~

(6) Conducting a feasibility study on the cost to save the lighthouses; and

(7) Investigating sources of financial and other assistance that may be available to save the lighthouses; ~~and~~ and

(8) Promoting a cooperative dialogue with other jurisdictions toward the preservation and restoration of lighthouses along the Atlantic seaboard.

(d) The members of the Commission shall select a chairperson from the membership.

(e) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, consistent with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly by ~~December 17, 1989~~ July 1, 1990, and thereafter terminate its existence.

(f) Staff for the Commission shall be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference and the Maryland Historical Trust.
