- (1) Developing an inventory of the location and condition of lighthouses in Maryland waters;
- (1) (2) Determining the kind of lighthouses to be saved;
 - (2) (3) Designating specific lighthouses to be saved;
- (3) (4) Determining, where necessary, new sites for lighthouses;
- (4) (5) Recommending, where appropriate, replacement
 of site markers with scenic structures;
- (5)--Developing--appropriate-signboards-to-be-attached to-lighthouses-welcoming-ships-to-Maryland-waters;
- (6) Conducting a feasibility study on the cost to save the lighthouses; and
- (7) Investigating sources of financial and other assistance that may be available to save the lighthouses---; and
- (8) Promoting a cooperative dialogue with other jurisdictions toward the preservation and restoration of lighthouses along the Atlantic seaboard.
- (d) The members of the Commission shall select a chairperson from the membership.
- (e) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, consistent with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly by Becember 17-1989 July 1, 1990, and thereafter terminate its existence.
- (f) Staff for the Commission shall be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference and the Maryland Historical Trust.
