CHAPTER 659

(House Bill 390)

AN ACT concerning

Law Enforcement, Correctional, and Public Safety Officers -
Death Benefits

FOR the purpose of altering the amount of death benefits to ~~survivors or the estates~~ certain survivors of certain law enforcement, public safety, and correctional officers killed in the line of duty; and altering the beneficiaries of the death benefit.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments
4-1002.

(a) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(1) "Law-enforcement officer" means:

(i) A law-enforcement officer as defined in Article 27, § 727 of the Code;

(ii) An officer serving in a probationary status;

(iii) An officer who serves at the pleasure of the appointing authority of a county, incorporated municipality, or Baltimore City;
