

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the local alcoholic beverages license issuing authority may waive the requirements under this Act if no alcohol awareness program has been approved or is available in the jurisdiction of the local license issuing authority.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder or holder's designee of any class of an on-premises retail alcoholic beverages license shall complete the alcohol awareness program prior to September, 1990.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not apply to any holder of any class of a retail alcoholic beverages license who completed an alcohol awareness program no more than 5 years prior to July 1, 1989, if the program is approved by the Comptroller under the provisions of Section 1 of this Act.

(House Bill 402)

AN ACT concerning

Delegate Scholarship Program
