- (e) (l) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, a person with a consolidated hunting license may -f-also purchase-f-  $\theta BTAIN$  a second deer stamp from the Department.
- (2) The second deer stamp allows the person with the consolidated hunting license to hunt 1 extra deer in each of the following hunting seasons for deer in the State:
  - (i) Bow and arrow season;
  - (ii) Black powder season; and
- (iii) After July 1, 1989, regular firearms season.
- (3) -{-The fee for the second deer stamp issued in accordance with this subsection shall be \$10.50 \$5.00 -}- ON REQUEST-OF-THE-PERSON,-THE-DEPARTMENT-MAY-ISSUE-WITHOUT-CHARGE--A SECOND-DEER-STAMP-TO-THE-PERSON.
- (4) The Department may limit by regulation the type and number of deer stamps issued under this subsection if necessary to control the deer harvest in various areas of the State.
- (f) (l) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, a person with a basic hunting license and any individual hunting stamp may -{-also purchase-}- OBTAIN a second stamp from the Department.
- (2) (i) Except as provided in item (ii) of this subparagraph, the second deer stamp allows the person with the basic license to hunt 1 extra deer in each hunting season for which the person has purchased an individual hunting stamp.
- (ii) A second deer stamp shall not be available for regular firearms season until after July 1, 1989 and shall be issued in accordance with regulations adopted by the Department.
- (3) -{-The fee for the second stamp issued in accordance with this subsection shall be \$10.50 \$5.00 -}- ON REQUEST-OF-THE-PERSON,-THE-DEPARTMENT-MAY-ISSUE-WITHOUT-CHARGE-A SECOND-DEER-STAMP-TO-THE-PERSON.
