8-509. OBTAINING FEE OR SALE THROUGH FRAUD OR MISREPRESENTATION.

WHILE PROVIDING OR OFFERING TO PROVIDE HEARING AID SERVICES, A PERSON MAY NOT OBTAIN A FEE OR MAKE A SALE THROUGH FRAUD OR MISREPRESENTATION.

8-510. EMPLOYING UNAUTHORIZED PERSON.

A PERSON MAY NOT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY EMPLOY TO PROVIDE HEARING AID SERVICES ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT LICENSED OR WHOSE LICENSE IS SUSPENDED.
