

(d) The planning board or district council of Prince George's County or Montgomery County shall take action only in regard to zoning or land use planning matters within their respective counties.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

(House Bill 875)

AN ACT concerning

Washington Suburban Sanitary District -
Bond Issue - Water
MC/PG 15-89

FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance of bonds for the Washington Suburban Sanitary District in an amount not exceeding \$75,000,000 for enlarging, increasing, and augmenting the water supply and major distribution facilities of the Sanitary District; providing that the bonds shall be guaranteed as to payment of principal and interest by the County Council of Montgomery County and the County Council of Prince George's County, or the governing body for each county, respectively, as may be provided by law or instrument of Charter, with a provision for waiver of the guarantee at the option of the Commission; providing for the payment of the bonds and the interest on the bonds by levy of taxes against assessable property within the Sanitary District; providing for the collection of water service charges; and providing for the ratification and confirmation of any guarantee made by the County Council of Montgomery County and the County Council of Prince George's County, or the governing body for each county, respectively, as may be provided by law or instrument of Charter, of any water supply bonds of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District heretofore issued.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, created by Chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1918, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$75,000,000 which bonds
