8-518. UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES.

WHILE PROVIDING OR OFFERING TO PROVIDE HEARING AID SERVICES, A PERSON MAY NOT ENGAGE IN AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE, AS DEFINED IN § 13-301 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE.
