~~(E)~~ (F) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS OR BOTH:

(I) FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE, \$500; AND

(II) FOR THE SECOND OFFENSE, \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT OF 30 DAYS OR BOTH.

(2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT LIMIT OR SUPERSEDE ANY OTHER PENALTY THAT MAY BE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY OTHER LAW OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(G) ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT UNDER TITLE 10 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

AN ACT concerning

Information Processing Equipment Replacement Fund

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning to designate certain equipment as being subject to certain financial requirements; requiring certain units of State government to establish depreciation schedules for certain equipment and to collect an allowance for replacement cost; establishing an Information Processing Equipment Replacement Fund to be used to finance the purchase of information processing equipment for certain
