- (3) ALL MONEYS RECEIVED UPON DISPOSITION OF INFORMATION PROCESSING EQUIPMENT PURCHASED FROM THE FUND.
- (E) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD AND THE STATE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- (2) THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.
- (3) INVESTMENT EARNINGS SHALL ACCRUE TO THE CREDIT OF THE GENERAL FUND.
- (F) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND SHALL BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN APPROPRIATION APPROVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 722

(House Bill 1065)

AN ACT concerning

Crimes and Punishments - Harmful Access to Computers, Systems, and Services

- FOR-the--purpose--of--prohibiting--intentional--and--unauthorized harmful--access--to-computers-and-certain-devices-or-systems related-to-computers;-providing-certain-penalties;-providing for-restitution;-clarifying-language;-and-generally-relating to-crimes-relating-to-computers;
- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from accessing, attempting to access, or causing access to a computer or certain systems or services concerning a computer under certain circumstances; prohibiting a person from identifying or attempting to identify, distribute, or publicize certain codes under certain circumstances; altering the definitions of certain terms; providing certain penalties; clarifying language; and generally relating to access to a computer or certain systems or services concerning a computer.
