CHAPTER 731

(House Bill 1215)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority - Contract Financing Fund --Financial-Assistance-Applications

FOR the purpose of altering-certain-limitations-on-the-power-of the-Maryland-Small-Business-Development-Pinancing-Authority to-guarantee-loans-and-make-loans-by-deleting-a-certain term;--altering--the--information--required--on-certain applications-for-financial--assistance;-authorizing--the Maryland-Small--Business-Development-Pinancing-Authority-to delegate--the--review--and--approval--of--certain--financial assistance-application-information permitting the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority to delegate to the executive director of the Authority the review and approval of certain requirements of an application for financial assistance from the Contract Financing Fund under certain circumstances; eliminating a descriptive qualifier relating to contracts and projects reviewed by the Authority; and generally relating to the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority Contract Financing Fund.
