- (4) In addition to any other provision, the regulations shall require:
- (i) The local department of social services or the Juvenile Services Agency to develop a plan within 45 days of placement of a child in a shelter care facility to assess the child's treatment needs; and
- (ii) The plan to be submitted to all parties to the petition and their counsel.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

## AN ACT concerning

Workers' Compensation - Handicapped Students

FOR the purpose of providing workers' compensation coverage for certain handicapped students under certain circumstances; specifying the level of compensation to be provided; authorizing a county board of education to obtain workers' compensation coverage for handicapped students under certain circumstances; exempting certain handicapped students from the coverage of this Act; and generally relating to workers' compensation coverage for certain handicapped students.
