CHAPTER 743

(House Bill 1383)

AN ACT concerning

Property Tax - Nonprofit Fire Companies or Rescue Squads

FOR the purpose of exempting from property tax certain property owned by an incorporated, nonprofit fire company or rescue squad that is used as a residence for certain individuals; and providing for the applicability of this Act.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Tax - Property Section 7-209 Annotated Code of Maryland (1986 Volume and 1988 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

7-209.

Property is not subject to property tax if the property:

- (1) is owned by an incorporated, nonprofit fire company or rescue squad; and
- (2) is necessary for and actually used exclusively for the purposes of the fire company or rescue squad, including property that:
 - (i) is used for:
 - 1. training; or
 - fund raising at carnivals or bazaars;
- (ii) is held in an advanced land acquisition program of the fire company or rescue squad;
