

(C)-(1)--A JUDGMENT DEBTOR MAY PETITION A COURT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION FOR EXPUNGEMENT OF A JUDGMENT DEBT THAT HAS BEEN PAID AND LACKS EVIDENCE OF SATISFACTION, OR FOR WHICH A VALID OFFER OF FULL PAYMENT WAS MADE BY THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR WITHIN 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ENTRY OF THE JUDGMENT OR WITHIN 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF FINAL AFFIRMANCE BY AN APPELLATE COURT, WHICHEVER IS LATER.

(2)--THE PETITION TO EXPUNGE THE JUDGMENT DEBT SHALL INCLUDE PROOF THAT THE JUDGMENT DEBT WAS PAID OR THAT A VALID OFFER OF FULL PAYMENT WAS MADE BY THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR.

(3)--SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, A JUDGMENT DEBT THAT HAS BEEN PAID AND LACKS EVIDENCE OF SATISFACTION, OR FOR WHICH A VALID OFFER OF FULL PAYMENT IS MADE WITHIN 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ENTRY OF THE JUDGMENT OR WITHIN 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF FINAL AFFIRMANCE BY AN APPELLATE COURT, WHICHEVER IS LATER, SHALL BE EXPUNGED ON ORDER OF THE COURT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(D)--A PETITION FOR EXPUNGEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE FILED IN THE COURT IN WHICH THE JUDGMENT WAS AWARDED.

(E)-(1)--IF NO OBJECTION TO A PETITION FOR EXPUNGEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS FILED BY A PARTY WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE FILING OF THE PETITION, A COURT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION SHALL ORDER A JUDGMENT DEBT EXPUNGED.

(2)-(1)--IF AN OBJECTION TO A JUDGMENT DEBTOR'S PETITION TO EXPUNGE THE JUDGMENT DEBT IS FILED BY A PARTY TO THE ACTION WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE FILING OF THE PETITION, THE COURT SHALL CONDUCT A HEARING.

(II)--IF THE COURT FINDS THAT A JUDGMENT DEBTOR IS ENTITLED TO EXPUNGEMENT, THE COURT SHALL ORDER THE JUDGMENT DEBT EXPUNGED, OR, OTHERWISE, THE COURT SHALL DENY THE PETITION.

(III)--THE COURT MAY AWARD ATTORNEYS' FEES TO EITHER PARTY.

(F)--A PARTY WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY THE DECISION OF THE COURT HAS THE RIGHT OF APPELLATE REVIEW AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

(G)--UPON AUTOMATIC EXPUNGEMENT OF THE JUDGMENT DEBT AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, OR COURT ORDERED EXPUNGEMENT AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (C), (D), AND (E) OF THIS SECTION, THE CLERK OF THE COURT SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER OF EXPUNGEMENT TO PERSONS WHO HAVE RECEIVED INFORMATION ON THE JUDGMENT.

(H)-(1)--IF A PERSON FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF EXPUNGEMENT WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE ORDER, THE
