- (2) On the basis of the neurological examination of the individual and the recommendation of the licensed physician or surgeon who specalizes in neurology or neurosurgery, the Commission may:
- (i) Refuse to issue or renew for the individual a license to participate as a contestant in a boxing match; or
- (ii) Prohibit the individual from participating as a contestant in a boxing match in the State.
- (3) The Commission shall pay for the cost of a neurological examination required under this subsection from the license fees collected under this section.
- [(4) The physician or surgeon conducting the neurological examination required under this subsection shall not be considered an employee of the State.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 755

(House Bill 1466)

AN ACT concerning

Pump-Out Stations

FOR the purpose of specifying that on or after a certain date the Department of Natural Resources shall install certain pump-out stations on-site at certain boat launching facilities or marinas; requiring-the-Department-to-conduct-a certain-survey-and-assess-the-adequacy-of-certain-existing pump-out-stations-and-report-its-findings-to-a-certain committee; and generally relating to pump-out stations.
