- (4) TO MONITOR THE USE OF MONEYS GRANTED FROM THE FUND; -AND
- (5)--TO-REPORT-TO--THE-GOVERNOR--AND;--SUBJECT--TO--\$ 2-1312--OF--THE-STATE-GOVERNMENT-ARTICLE;-TO-THE-GENERAL-ASSEMBLY BEFORE-JANUARY-1-OF-EACH-YEAR-ON-THE-STATUS-OF-THE-FUND--AND-ON RECOMMENDATIONS--FOR--CHANGES--IN--LEGISLATION-AND-POLICY-FOR-THE PREVENTION-OF-CHILD-ABUSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Children's Trust Fund Advisory Board shall expire as follows:
 - (1) 3 members in 1992;
 - (2) 3 members in 1991; and
 - (3) 3 members in 1990.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

(House Bill 1508)
