The hours specified in §§ 83 to 85, inclusive, of this article, shall apply except as modified by §§ 86 to 105, inclusive, of this article.

- (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.
- (4) In Kent County the hours [shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m.] OF SALE ARE AS PROVIDED UNDER § 101 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (g) In Kent County, the hours for exercising the privileges conferred by a seven day, Class A (off-sale) beer and light wine license are:
- (1) Six days--6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day.
- (2) Sunday--9:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day] AS PROVIDED UNDER § 101 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (c) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class C beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. the day following.
- (3) In Kent County the hours [shall be from 12 noon to 2 a.m. the following day] OF SALE ARE AS PROVIDED UNDER § 101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.
- (3) In Caroline County the hours shall be from 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday until 1 a.m. the following day (including Sunday). In Baltimore [and Kent counties] COUNTY the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m.
