## LAWS OF MARYLAND

WHEREAS, Certain groups have raised questions on the accuracy of the population estimates for Canada geese that the Department of Natural Resources made in its aerial surveys in mid-November, 1988 and in midwinter, 1989; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly intends this Act to provide the Department of Natural Resources with added services in order to add credibility to the Department's population estimates for all wild waterfowl; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-210.

IN THE PLANNING OF SAMPLING METHODS AND THE COMPILATION OF ESTIMATES OF THE NUMBER OF WILD WATERFOWL IN THE STATE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT-AND-COOPERATE-WITH-AND-USE-THE STATISTICS-OF TAKE ADVANTAGE OF OTHER SURVEYS MADE BY RELIABLE ORGANIZATIONS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- (1) THE GRAND NATIONAL WATERFOWL HUNT, INCORPORATED;
  - (2) THE MARYLAND OUTFITTERS ASSOCIATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

(House Bill 1576)
