

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2, and 5 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989, and shall remain effective for a period of 1 year. At the end of June 30, 1990, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 2, and 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1, 3, and 4 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the new members of the Commission as provided in this Act shall be as follows:~~

AN ACT concerning

Department of State Planning - State Clearinghouse
for Intergovernmental Assistance

FOR the purpose of establishing in the Department of State Planning a repository and clearinghouse for information concerning federal and State financial and technical assistance; requiring the Department to publish a certain catalog of State assistance programs; requiring the Department to adopt regulations to require certain units of State government to publish certain information on State grants in the Maryland Register within a certain time and to submit certain information to the Department; providing for the transfer of certain duties of the Department of State Planning to the Office of Planning under certain conditions; and generally relating to the establishment of a
